



Realizing the relevance of Sikh philosophy in the entire knowledge traditions of the world and the need for contemplation and great effort regarding the universality of Sri Guru Granth Sahib Ji, the Sri Guru Granth Sahib Chair has been established. The entire work of research and contemplation under this chair is dedicated to the Universality of Sri Guru Granth Sahib Ji. It is worth mentioning that under the 'Sant Baba Malkit Singh Memorial Chair' established earlier, the research work related to Nirmala sect and Sikh thought is going on very seriously.

Sant Baba Malkit Singh Ji Chair

Sant Baba Malkit Singh Ji Chair is established at SBBSU which provides scholarships to promote and encourage research among the scholars of the university. It was started at the initiative of Dr. Harpreet Singh & Dr. Anita Rani is working as a chair fellow. Apart from carrying out various research projects, national/international seminars/conferences, publication of rare books is also being done under this chair. It also offers scholarships for research on the 'Nirmala' Sampradaya, the sector spiritual lineage to which Baba Ji belonged.

BRIEF OVERVIEW OF UNIVERSITY

(ACADEMIC SESSION 2024-25)

In the academic year 2024-25, the SBBS University Jalandhar, Punjab, India. demonstrated remarkable advancement across all dimensions of scholarly endeavours. The University's 8 Institutes and 14 Departments showcased the customary indications of vigorous development and potential. This year as well, SBBS University maintained excellence in all academic research criteria, displayed through a high h-index and relative research paper citations. These metrics serve as substantial evidence of the vibrant research milieu at SBBS University, which inspires and supports research excellence.

SBBS University, a significant number of high-quality academic works have been published, including 208 research and review papers featured in SCI, Scopus, UGC Care-listed, and peer-reviewed journals. Additionally, SBBS University has contributed to the academic community by publishing 18 books through both international and national publishers. Furthermore, 60 book chapters have been published under the Scopus-indexed conferences organized by international and national bodies. These accomplishments highlight the University commitment to advancing knowledge and fostering scholarly excellence across various disciplines.

The university has further strengthened its reputation for innovation by securing 04 patents and receiving numerous research awards, reflecting its commitment to cutting-edge advancements. SBBS University faculty members have been recognized for their excellence, earning several awards for research, achievements, and contributions from private bodies and prestigious institutes. SBBS University has played key roles in the academic community by serving as editorial board members for international and national journals, as well as reviewers for Scopus-indexed conferences. The university takes pride in its strong placement record, by achieving 75% placement, while its students actively participate and excel in national hackathons, demonstrating their technical prowess on renowned platforms.

Students of SBBS University have showcased outstanding achievements in various sports at national and university-level competitions. Mr. Deepak Gujjar, a B.P.Ed student, secured a Silver Medal in the 20 km Race Walk at the AIU Athletics Championship (2024-2025) and qualified for the Khelo India University Games 2025. SBBS University Football Team also excelled, winning Silver Medals in two tournaments and Gold Medals in two others. Additionally, Rohit Kumar (B.P.Ed) won multiple medals in Wushu competitions, while Ramandeep Singh (B.P.Ed) earned Gold and Silver Medals in track events at national games. Sujata Jassi, an M.P.Ed student, clinched Gold and Bronze Medals in Kickboxing, and Mr. Badal (B.P.E.S) secured Gold in the National Wrestling Championship.

SBBS University has implemented several impactful initiatives under Unnat Bharat Abhiyan (UBA), adopted eight nearby villages to drive rural development through education, healthcare, skill training, and

sustainability programs. Key efforts include digital literacy camps, Repair & Reuse Drives (monthly sustainability workshops), health check-up camps, and women empowerment programs. SBBS University also promotes a drug-free campus, anti-ragging measures, and gender sensitization, ensuring a safe, inclusive environment. Additionally, SBBS University boasts world-class sports infrastructure, fostering athletic excellence alongside academics. These initiatives reflect the university's commitment to holistic education, community engagement, and sustainable development.

The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of SBBS University plays a pivotal role in maintaining and enhancing academic and administrative excellence. It systematically monitors teaching-learning processes, research initiatives, and infrastructure development to ensure compliance with national quality benchmarks. By fostering a culture of continuous improvement, the IQAC conducts regular audits, feedback collection from stakeholders, and implements best practices to elevate institutional performance. It also coordinates accreditation processes of NAAC and promotes innovation in curriculum design, faculty development, and student-centric initiatives, aligning with the university's mission of delivering high-quality education and holistic growth.

SBBS University supports faculty by providing seed money to encourage innovative projects, research, and startup initiatives. To encourage the young faculty members university has provided the financial assistance of Rupees Ten Lakh in the form of Seed Money. The University has also spent an amount of 13.5 lakhs for the purchase of books and journals through library. Additionally, SBBS University develops e-content for SWAYAM courses, ensuring accessible and interactive online learning materials aligned with national education standards. These efforts enhance digital education, promote academic excellence, and empower both educators and learners with cutting-edge resources.

SBBS University follows the UGC's New Education Policy (NEP) 2020 guidelines, incorporating Indian Knowledge Systems (IKS), Jeevan Kaushal (Life Skills), Environmental Studies, Community Engagement & Social Responsibility, Human Values & Professional Ethics, and Apprenticeship/Internship into university curriculum. Curriculum is being Introduced as per NEP-2020 and UGC, New Delhi directions from time to time.

In December 2024, SBBS University achieved a 93% result and honored its outstanding students by awarding the Gold Medal and Degrees to the Students. In March 2025, Roll of Honour was presented to top performers from each institute. The recognitions awarded included Academic Achievers (honoring the first two toppers of each semester), University Colour, and the prestigious SBBSU Excellence Award, all of which celebrated outstanding excellence and dedication in academics.

The core idea behind this practice is to organize "Fix-it" days, where students, faculty, staff, and even members from the surrounding communities are invited to bring broken tools, appliances, or small machines to the university. Under the guidance of experienced mentors and technical experts, these items are repaired, and participants are taught valuable repair and maintenance skills. The drives not only help in reducing waste and encouraging reuse but also create awareness about environmental responsibility. For students, the Repair & Reuse Drives serve as an excellent hands-on learning experience. Engineering and vocational students, in particular, benefit immensely as they apply theoretical knowledge in real-life scenarios, enhancing their problem-solving abilities and technical proficiency. It promotes a culture of sustainability and self-reliance, instilling in students the value of conservation over consumerism.

Moreover, the initiative strengthens university-community relationships, as local residents gain access to useful services and students gain exposure to real-world challenges. The monthly rhythm of the event ensures continuous learning, environmental consciousness, and societal contribution, making it a model best practice that aligns with the vision of holistic education at SBBS University.

1.3: Healthcare and Hygiene Initiatives

1.3.1 Objective: To promote physical well-being, preventive healthcare, and awareness about common diseases.

1.3.2 Activities:

4.4. Recognition & Future Goals


- SBBS University's outreach work has received appreciation from local administration and statelevel bodies.
