3. Academic Achievements

The University's Convocation Ceremony was solemnly conducted in November 2025. The Convocation marked a significant milestone in the lives of the students as degrees were conferred upon **600 graduates**, including **undergraduates, postgraduates, and 21 Ph.D. scholars**. During the year, our faculty and scholars published over 120 research papers in reputed national and international journals & more than 50 books & book Chapters. Five patents were filed, and two have been granted. The University has also established an Innovation and Incubation Centre to support start-ups and student entrepreneurship. A number of research collaborations have been initiated with industries and other universities, encouraging joint projects and knowledge exchange.
