Subject: General Rules for North Zone Inter University Football (Men) Tournament 2025-26

Dear Sir/Madam

On behalf of Sant Baba Bhag Singh University, we warmly welcome all participating universities to the North Zone Inter-University Football (Men) Tournament 2025–26, scheduled to be held from 05 to 11 January 2026 at Sant Baba Bhag Singh University. The fixture is enclosed for kind reference.

- The University is located approximately **30 km from Jalandhar Railway Station** and **27 km from Phagwara Railway Station**.
- The tournament will be conducted as per **AIU and FIFA rules**, and the decision of the Organizing Committee shall be final in all matters. Teams must carry proof of **AIU Annual Subscription** and the receipt of **online registration fee of ₹5,000/-**, paid through the AIU portal.
- Accommodation will be provided on the University campus for 22 players and officials per team, available 24 hours prior to the first match and up to 12 hours after the last match. Bedding will be provided at **₹80 per head per day**. Teams are advised to carry warm clothing and personal locks.
- The use of **liquor, drugs, smoking, and non-vegetarian food (including eggs)** is strictly prohibited on the campus.
- Transport from/to the railway station will be provided at **₹2,000 per team (one side)**.
- All teams must take meals from the University mess only. Meal charges of **₹270/- (per day)**, for **three days must be paid in advance**. Refunds, if applicable, will be settled at the time of checkout. No claims regarding refunds will be entertained after departure.
- Players must carry institutional identity cards, duly attested eligibility documents, and report in proper kit at least 30 minutes before the scheduled match time. The Manager/Coach shall be responsible for discipline and submission of eligibility documents.



- The Manager shall submit **five copies of the Eligibility Performa**, duly signed by the competent authority. Teams must carry the original DMC and photocopies of relevant academic documents, migration, Aadhaar Card, and Academic Bank of Credit (ABC ID), duly attested.
- Officiating charges as per the AIU norms must be deposited before the conduct of each match. A security deposit of ₹2,000 per team shall be deposited and will be refunded at the time of vacating accommodation after adjustment of dues, if any.
- **A Managers'/Coaches' Meeting** will be held at **04:00 PM on 04 January 2026** at the **Seminar Hall, Block-5 (Ground Floor)**.




Fixtures of the North Zone Inter-University Football (Men) Tournament 2025–26

Group A




