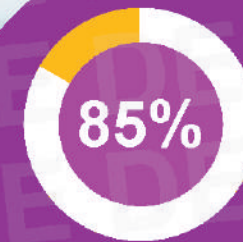

Often referred to as the "evergreen" branch due to its versatility, Civil Engineering offers numerous career opportunities across various industries, making it a highly sought-after field.

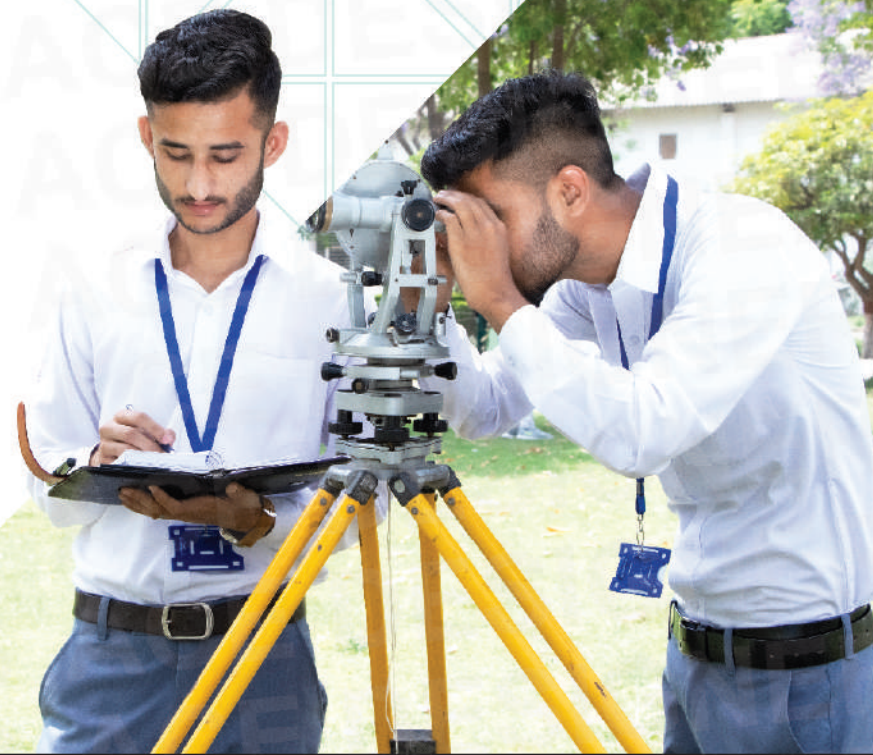
The B. Tech program in Civil Engineering is designed to provide students with a strong foundation in the core principles of Civil Engineering, emphasizing global, societal, and environmental contexts in line with sustainable development practices. Our curriculum is aimed at preparing students to tackle complex engineering challenges by identifying, formulating, and solving problems related to structural design, transportation, water resources, geotechnical engineering, and urban development, while ensuring adherence to cost, safety, quality, and ethical standards.

The Civil Engineering department boasts a faculty with extensive expertise across specialized fields, supported by dedicated technical staff. The department fosters hands-on learning through field trips, practical projects, and industry-academic interactions, ensuring students gain real-world experience. This comprehensive approach equips graduates with the skills needed to meet the ever-evolving demands of the industry. By continually updating our curriculum to reflect industry trends and societal needs, we ensure that our students are well-prepared to contribute to the development of infrastructure and the built environment globally. Upon graduation, our students are highly valued by employers and are ready to take on the challenges of modern civil engineering.

CAREER PROSPECTS

Civil engineers in the government sector work on large-scale public infrastructure projects like roads, bridges, airports, dams, and water systems. Key roles include positions in the Public Works Department (PWD), Municipal Corporations, and local bodies (**Assistant Engineer, Junior Engineer [JE], SDO, Water Supply Engineer**). Public Sector Undertakings (PSUs) like BHEL, NTPC, and SAIL offer opportunities in energy, steel, and power plants (Project Engineer, Structural Engineer, Construction Manager). The Defence Services require civil engineers for military infrastructure (Engineering Officer, Project Manager). Agencies like IRC and NHAI hire engineers for infrastructure planning and monitoring. Civil engineers can also pursue UPSC roles for leadership positions. Railways and airports offer roles in construction and maintenance (Civil Engineer, Project Manager, Infrastructure Planner). Government jobs provide job stability, pension, benefits, and better work-life balance with lower work pressure compared to the private sector.

In the private sector, civil engineers can find higher pay and innovative projects. Construction firms offer roles like Site Engineer, Project Manager, and Construction Manager for residential, commercial, and industrial projects. Consultancy firms need Design Engineers, Structural Engineers, and Geotechnical Engineers for specialized services. Real estate companies hire Project Engineers and Site Managers for property developments. Engineering and design firms focus on infrastructure like roads and bridges, with roles such as Structural and Hydraulic Engineers. Infrastructure companies need engineers for highways, airports, and ports. In the energy sector, engineers work on power plants, wind farms, and solar installations. Research and development offer roles like Research Engineer and Materials Engineer for innovation in construction techniques. The private sector provides higher salary potential, career growth, and exposure to cutting-edge projects.

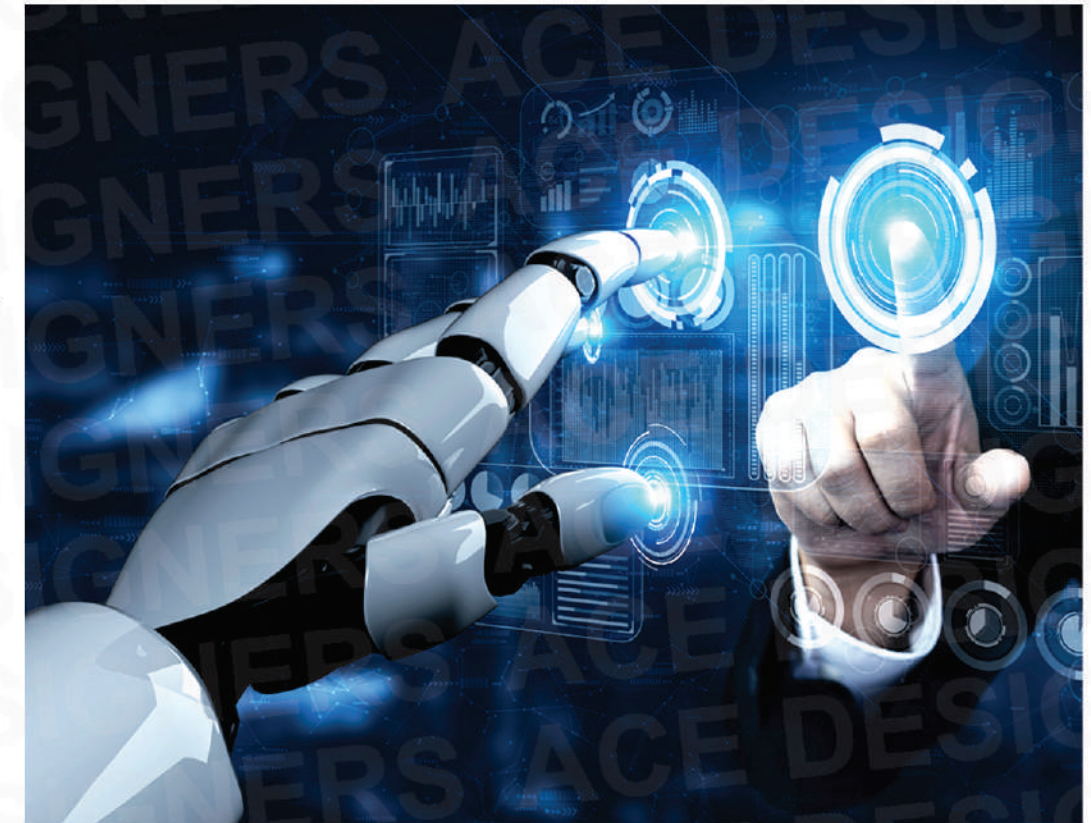

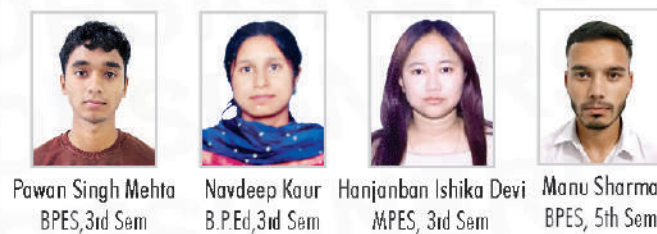

CENTRAL FACILITIES

COMPUTER CENTRE

The University has centralized computer centre to cater to the needs of faculty, staff and students in addition to facilities available in various departments of the university. The computer centre is well equipped with personal computers of latest configuration, Core 2 Duo, i3, i5 (8th/10th/11th Generation). It facilitates the students and the faculty in developing a number of research applications. The university is well connected with 500 Mbps dedicated 1:1 Internet leased line connectivity. The university has also a backup line of 50 Mbps leased line. The University campus has Wi-Fi compliance available 24x7. University has a Microsoft Cloud Campus Agreement License Kit with unlimited licensed software, Oracle certification. The following facilities are available in different sections of the computer centre.

SERVER ROOM

High Configuration Servers are provided in the Server room (AIX IBM p505 series server, IBM x3250M4 and IBM x3200M3 Servers) supporting university website Hosting server, Library Automation Server, Internet Bandwidth Management Server, IMS Server, Biometric Management Server and email server.

FACULTY LAB

Faculty Lab is well equipped with appropriate internet connectivity. It provides the internet facility to the faculty and staff which helps in the continuous improvement of knowledge, teaching methodologies, project work and research.

STUDENT SERVICE CENTRE

The Student Service Centre is well equipped with latest configuration personal computers, equipped with laser 3 in 1 printer, scanner and DVD writer. It provides the facility to the students for taking printouts and scanning of documents and writing of CD's and DVD's for the assignments, lectures.

INTERNET LAB

Internet laboratory provides facilities for academic and technical development which helps the students to prepare for the global market. The campus is provided with efficient network with 24 hours Wi-Fi Connectivity. Database lab is used for teaching concepts of Database Management System and is equipped with Oracle Server & SQL Server. Remote experiments are carried out in collaboration with IIT Delhi. Students also get benefit of working and obtaining credits through MOOC Course.

MEDIA STUDIO

The university has a high-tech media studio provided to the faculty and staff to conduct and manage events online.

CENTRAL LIBRARY

Sant Baba Bhag Singh University has a Central Library and branches in the University Institutes; it is the central service unit to facilitate help in creation of new knowledge and information through the Current Awareness Services (CAS), Selective Dissemination of Information (SDI), E-resources, print and non-print resources. The Sant Baba Bhag Singh University Central Library serves as a model of an evolving and dynamic facility in technical learning. The library, as an established knowledge hub that is conveniently accessible by those associated with the University, has a major contribution and making top ranked Academic & Research driven university. The Library's collection comprises hybrid resources (Print & Electronic) in the field of science and technology, engineering, management, law and hotel management. The Library also has a separate Internet section consisting of a number of networked terminals for providing recent and most comprehensive access to online journals, online databases and other online reference resources to the faculty, students and staff under Intranet and Internet environment. The Central library has automated all its routine activities through library software E-Granthalya, D-Space Institutional repository and also extended the scope of various services like CD-ROM database search, OPAC and Web based OPAC. New Arrivals have Databases of books in English, Punjabi and Hindi languages. As soon as new books are purchased and processed, their bibliographic description is added in the OPAC. Computer terminals have been dedicated for the readers to use OPAC for their search of books. In addition to OPAC this facility is also available on INTRANET within University Campus to benefit the students/faculty members by giving access to catalogue at their respective departments. The entire library collections including book, e-books, journals, databases can be searched and browsed through the Web enabled Online Public Access Catalogue (OPAC). Users can access the OPAC to find out the real time availability of books, CDs, Thesis, dissertations etc, from the computer terminals, webpage of the library, faculty and students can hold the library resources which is on Loan. The Library offers computerized Catalogue Search Services through the Web OPAC (Online Public Access Catalogue). The bibliographic records consisting of books, pamphlets, reports, Thesis and Dissertations are available in the Central Library of Sant Baba Bhag Singh University can be searched through this interface. To access Web OPAC sufficient numbers of PCs are placed in the user's area. Timing of Library is from 8 AM to 11 PM.

- Sant Baba Bhag Singh University Central Library academic community is well catered by all departmental libraries. There are more than 10000 e-journals and number of e-books on all subject fields. The Central Library is having sufficient print resources such as books, journals, magazines, maps, drawings and non-print resources.
- The Central Library system and Institutional libraries subscribes number of journals, magazines and newspapers.
- Library system also provides ICT based resources to its users, such as e-books, e-journals, databases. The E-resources subscribed by University Library are J-Gate, DELNET, EBSCO, Shodhganga, Shodhgangotri, Shodhsindhu, INFLIBNET, NDL etc.
- Central Library of the university also manages finest Institutional Repository for thesis and dissertations. A high-quality number of thesis/dissertations and research reports are available in libraries.
- In addition to books, library system also possesses rare book collection, special reports, reference sources, audio-visual material etc.
- Library system uses E-Granthalya for handling day-to-day routine responsibilities of all the libraries. It makes use of Barcode system for inventory and security of library materials.
- Academic community is well catered by the Central and as well as all departmental libraries.
- Central Library of the University also manages an Institutional Repository for thesis and dissertations.
- A good number of thesis/dissertations and research reports are available in libraries.

Printed e-journals

Central Library is subscribing Foreign and Indian e-Journals and e-books. The library is a member of DELNET, National Digital Library (NDL), and is subscribing the e-journals and e-books, thesis, audio, video, book series and conference proceedings through J-Gate.

DELNET

Central Library is a member of DELNET (Developing Library Network). This will help the faculty and researchers to procure those e-books, e-journals, rare books, Language Gainer Portal, Knowledge Gainer Portal, thesis, dissertations and documents which are available on DELNET.

Computer Section

The library has its own computer section. All library operations such as housekeeping, bibliographic services, cataloguing of new books, preparation of data base of books with complete bibliographical details of all books and serial control are carried out by computer section. Bar-coding of books is being done at a rapid speed in order to make the circulation work fully computerized. It has prepared a number of databases of books, periodicals, manuscripts etc.

Central Library has started the digitalization of the thesis, dissertations, project reports, rare books, manuscripts and important documents are being digitalized and the thesis, dissertations, project reports, rare books, manuscripts and important documents are being preserved.

Reading Hall

Central Library has a reading hall, which remains open from 8:00 AM to 9:00 PM. Library attendants remains present at every time in the reading hall to provide assistance to the students.

Current Awareness Service

Students, research scholars and faculty members are constantly kept aware of the latest books added to the library through display of selected books and book jackets in the new arrival corner. Displays are also organized on various occasions. 'Books of the month: bibliographical detail of the books', is sent to all the departments from time to time in printed form as well as through e-mail. Articles, news clippings are also sent to the research scholars and academic community of the Sant Baba Bhag Singh University.

Orientation Programmes and Awareness programs

Library Orientation Programmes and Awareness programs are arranged for the new students in the beginning of the session to familiarize them with various library services, sections of the library and their working. Free training to use Internet is also provided to the new students. Library Orientation Programs and Awareness programs are also organized for the students of the different schools to make them aware about the facilities being provided in the Central Library.

J. SPORTS SCHOLARSHIP

1. FEE CONCESSION

- 100% Total fee exempted for International Player and Free Hostel and Free Meals for one year.
- 100% Tuition Fee Exempted for one semester (6 months) will be offered to sports person who while pursuing his/her studies in School/Diploma/University won medal in Open National/School National/SGF/Diploma/All India Intervarsity/North Zone Intervarsity within last one year in any Sports/Event along with current performance and trials to be taken.
- 75% Tuition fee relaxation will be offered to sports person who while pursuing his/her studies in School/Diploma/College/University participated in Open National, School National/ SGF/ North Zone/ All India Intervarsity level Tournaments within last one year in any Sports/Events.
- 50% Tuition Fee relaxation will be offered to sports person who while pursuing his/her studies in school/diploma won medal in District/State/Open State level tournament within last one year in any Sports Events.
- 35% Tuition Fee relaxation will be offered to sports person who while pursuing his/her studies in school has participated in District State/Open State level tournament within last one year in any Sports Events.

Conditions

The student will get this benefit at the time of Admission in the institute for the first session only.

For Exemption will continue for next session only if the

student wins any medal for the University in AIU Tournaments or in Open tournaments (to be recognized by federation of that discipline) in his/her chosen sport. If the student does not win any medal for the University in AIU Tournaments or in Open tournaments his/her chosen sport, the fee exemption will be withdrawn for next session.

- Depending upon the result and level of participation, Sports Committee will decide relaxation to be given or not.
- Student will be again eligible for fee exemption only when he/she will win medal for the University in AIU Tournaments or Open Tournaments event and that too in successive session.
- If the student has already enrolled in the University and wins medal for the University, 100% fee will be exempted in addition to cash award he/she wins (as per cash award norms)

2. FREE ACCOMMODATION

- At the time of admission one that gets medal in previous School/College/University and willing to avail hostel facility will be provided only free accommodation out of total hostel Fee, meal charges has to be paid by the student.
- Student who brings medal for the University will be given Free Accommodation for one semester.
- Hostel Fee Exemption will continue for next session only if the student wins any medal for the University in his/her chosen sport. If the student

does not win any medal for the University in his/her chosen sport, the fee exemption will be withdrawn for next session.

3. CASHAWARD

- The rules for cash award will be decided by the Hon'ble Chancellor.
- Remuneration to Team manager of SBBSU Inter Varsity Sports Team will be paid for the Inter Varsity Sports Tournament including the journey dates.
- Students of SBBSU Inter Varsity Sports Team will be paid Daily Allowance by the University for the journey period and actual participating days during the conduct of Inter-Varsity Sports Tournaments.
- ₹50/- to be paid to the students as refreshment during the actual match/ event day.
- The amount of Sports kit is ₹1500/- per head.

The Kit Includes:

- One Track Suit
- Two T-Shirt and shorts of different colours
- One pair of Socks
- One Kit Bag
- Team manager and coach may also be provided with same track suit and kit bag only.
- Team Manager can purchase only Iodex, Medicines and Glucose if required and if injury occurs, prescription/treatment chit of a Registered Medical Practitioner only to be attached with bills.
- Selected Teams should be sent for All Tournaments in which the University is having coaches.
- Certain Games Coaches can be hired for a month or two by paying remuneration of ₹500/- per day.
- ₹50/- as refreshment money will be provided to players prior to one month of tournament.
- Special sports person to be admitted under special Quota with the approval by the sports committee, Vice Chancellor and Chancellor.
- University colour to be given/awarded to the medal winner students, policy to be framed by sports department and get approved later on.

K. POST MATRIC SCHOLARSHIP SCHEME TO SC/ST STUDENTS

Post Matric Scholarship Scheme to SC/ST students is being offered by the State/Centre Government to the eligible students belonging to SC/ST categories whose family income is less than ₹2.5 lacs per annum. The students will have to submit three sets of the following documents at the time of admission:

- Income Certificate from Tehsildar issued in the name of student's father/guardian only.
- Residence Certificate.
- Caste certificate issued by competent authority i.e. Tehsildar.
- Photostat copies of Matric certificate and last examination passed.
- Photocopy of Aadhaar Card (UID) of student and parent.
- A copy of Bank account of claimant, linked with Aadhaar card for DBT and student's mobile number.
- One passport size photograph.

If a student fails to fulfill the following conditions, he will have to pay all the fee from his/her own resources for the period of their study at the University :

- The student does not complete his/her course of study at the University and leaves in between. OR
- The student does not attend 75% of the lectures in all subjects. OR
- The student does not pass an examination of any semester.

Note:

Claimant student is herself/himself responsible for applying online for SC scholarship by last date notified by the University every year. The University will only facilitate the students in applying online. The student, who fails to apply for scholarship online by the stipulated date, will have to deposit the fee.

Annual Income entered in Scholarship application should be the same as mentioned in income certificate otherwise scholarship application will be rejected.

Student who after passing one stage of education get admission in the same stage of education in different subject e.g. B.Sc. after B.A. or B.Com. after B.A. or M.A. in other subjects will not be eligible for Post Matric Scholarship Scheme to SC/ST students.

If the scholarship is not sanctioned by the Govt, even after applying for the same, the student will have to deposit the full fee.

As per the guidelines of scholarship scheme issued by the Centre Govt., students are required to deposit the course fee/tuition fee part (except maintenance allowance) within 07 days from the receipt of scholarship amount with the University.

Students are to follow all the instructions issued by the State Govt./ Centre Govt. from time to time.

A RAGGING FREE CAMPUS

RULES & REGULATIONS

A. GENERAL RULES

- A student shall conform to high standards of discipline and shall conduct himself/herself, within and outside the premises of the University, in a manner befitting the students and the University.
- He/She shall have a seriousness of purpose and shall in every way train himself/herself to lead a life of earnest endeavour and co-operation.
- He/She shall show due courtesy and consideration to the employees of the University and good neighbourliness to his fellow students, respect to the wardens of the hostel and the teachers of the University and pay due attention and courtesy to the visitors & members of society and other officials of the University.
- Ragging in any form is banned. Ragging is a criminal offence as per the Supreme Court ruling and FIR shall be registered against the student(s) found indulging in the crime.
- To safeguard its ideals, character and personal behaviour, University reserves the right to expel the students from the institution for any reason deemed sufficient.
- The Head of Department (HoD) can impose minor punishment such as fine up to ₹500/-. HOD can place a student under suspension from class/hostel in case of gross indiscipline on the part of student.
- Major punishment such as expulsion/rustication from the University, debarring the candidate from appearing in the university examination shall be executed by Dean Academics/Registrar on the result of enquiry conducted by disciplinary committee.
- Students and their parents/representatives are forbidden from addressing members of SBBSMCS Authorities.
- Consumption of non-vegetarian food, alcohol or any other intoxicant and smoking etc, are strictly prohibited in the University Campus.
- The guilty students shall be liable for punishment and disciplinary action which may include suspension, expulsion from the University or hostel or imposition of fine or both.
- Semester tuition fee and fine imposed, if any, is to be deposited in time, failing to do so may lead to suspension from classes/debarring from appearing in examination.
- All kinds of shouting or any act of movement or behaviour that is likely to cause disturbance of the teaching is strictly prohibited.
- Every student is to see that no damage is done to University property. Fitting and repair charges for the damage [intentional or negligence] are to be borne by the student.
- Regarding availing bus facility by the existing students, minimum three (03) months fee will be charged from the student if he/she discontinues availing the facility before mid-session or starts availing the facility after mid-session. Similarly full six months fee will be charged if he discontinues availing the facility after mid-session or starts availing the renewal facility before mid-session.

- The University reserves the right to make amendments in these rules & regulations from time to time.
- Eligible SC, ST, OBC, PWD students etc. should apply for the respective scholarship scheme for as per the guidelines issued by the State/Centre Govt. from time to time.
- All disputes pertaining to admission under the domain of admission brochure/prospectus are subject to the jurisdiction of the Courts of Jalandhar (Punjab) only.

SHIFTING OF COURSE

After the start of session, shifting will be made on the recommendation of COD/HoD/Dean and approval of the competent authority. For this purpose, fee deposited by him/her will be adjusted after charging ₹2000/- (for each shifting) as shifting charges fee.

MEDICAL FITNESS CERTIFICATE

The students will have to produce the medical fitness certificate from the Registered Medical Practitioner.

REFUND POLICY

The University follows the fee refund policy of UGC. The amount of fee to be refunded to a student, in case he/she chooses to withdraw from the programme of study in which he/she is enrolled, shall be as given below:

Students entitle the refund of their any type of security after the completion of their study within one year.

UNIFORM/DRESS CODE

In addition to being a valuable asset of the University, every student is also its brand ambassador. The conduct, behavior and the personal appearance of the student reflects on him as well as the University.

Thus, it is important for all students to follow the defined dress code/Uniform as per the notice/ circular issued in this regard. The students can purchase uniform from anywhere outside as per his/her choice.

It is mandatory for all the students to wear prescribed uniform as per dress code from 01 October 2025 onwards and 1st day of all other semesters. Students not wearing uniform will be fined ₹100/- per day.

CENTRAL LIBRARY

ACCESS TO LIBRARY RESOURCES AND COMPUTER BASED SERVICES

Readers have free access to books and periodicals displayed on open shelves. Reference books, Theses and Project Reports can be consulted only in the assigned area. Online Public Access Catalogue and Computer based library services are available. Members are free to seek assistance of library staff in selecting reading material, checking of references, and searching of misplaced reading material etc.

E-LIBRARY SERVICES

Library subscribes to EBSCO host to get access to major online databases and documents covering Education, Engineering & Technology, Law, Management, Pharmacy etc. Apart from this, library also facilitates access to more than 10,000 high quality Open Access Peer-Reviewed Journals; Full-Text Electronic Theses and Dissertations submitted to various Indian Universities and Institutes and about 1.00 Lac high quality e-books previously published by bonafide publishers.

MEMBERSHIP

Library members enjoy the privilege of borrowing books. The students and employees of SBBS University can enroll themselves as members by filling a prescribed application form and agreeing to abide by the rules. Others can use the library material only with special permission of Librarian.

LOAN PRIVILEGES

Normal check-out/check-in of library reading material is suspended half an hour before closing of Circulation Counter.

The Librarian can recall any reading material at any time if necessity arises.

OVERDUE CHARGES

1. General book ₹2.00 per book per day

2. Overnight Book/Periodical ₹2.00 per document per hour

REPROGRAPHIC SERVICES

Photostat service is available for the readers of library at nominal charges.

GENERAL

- Always bring library card while visiting the library. Visitor without Library Card/ Identity Card may be asked to leave the library.
- Particulars of personal Laptops and other computer peripherals to be taken inside the library should be recorded at the Gate Counter of Library.
- Keep all belongings like personal books & other printed material, umbrella, bags files etc. at the Property Rack.
- The "No Dues Certificate" can be secured from the library after surrendering library card and clearing all library dues.

- No library reading material would be considered returned until it has been returned properly at the circulation counter of library.
- Taking books out of the library without authorization, marking or underlining or in any way disfiguring and mutilating books or library property is a misdemeanor which may lead to withdrawal of library privileges or in serious cases to heavy fine and disciplinary action.
- Library is yours, love it and do not mutilate books. Books are for the generations to come.
- At the time of issue, the borrower should check condition of the book to be issued. In case it is damaged or not in good condition, it should be pointed out to the library officials at the Circulation Counter otherwise last borrower shall be responsible for any damage to the book/periodical etc.
- Get yourself checked at exit of library while you go outside.
- Eating/Drinking in the library premises is strictly prohibited to keep away ants, flies, and other insects etc.
- Maintain PIN DROP SILENCE in and around the Library premises.

IDENTITY CARD RULES

- It is compulsory to Display/Possession of identity cards by all students of the campus for identification and security reasons.
- Every student must wear identity Card while in University premises.
- Failure to produce the identity card on demand by the competent authority will lead to disciplinary action/imposition of fine.
- Loss of identity card must be reported to Head of Department or Dean immediately and a new card will be obtained immediately. The fee for the replacement will be ₹100/-.
- University has the right to expel the student from university if the student is found not wearing the Identity Card 10 times.

ATTENDANCE RULES

- A student must be regular and punctual in attendance.
- If a student remains absent from the University continuously for ten days, his/her name will be struck off from University rolls.
- He/She may be re-admitted on the payment of readmission fee and penalty. He/She will not be allowed to attend the class till he/she is readmitted.
- A student must fulfill the requirement of attendance as laid down by the university, minimum 75% attendance is mandatory, failing which, he/she will be detained from appearing in the university examinations.

LEAVE RULES

- Normally a student is expected to attend all classes. Absence from classes without valid reason is an act of indiscipline. It is mandatory for a student to have 75% attendance of scheduled classes for appearing in University examination.

- Students absenting themselves without any valid reason shall be liable to disciplinary action including fine.
- The medical officer must recommend leave application on medical ground. Father/Guardian of student must countersign such application before it is sent to the University. Medical officer will clearly specify the disease and the period of rest recommended.
- Medical Certificate along with Fitness Certificate from the competent authority must be submitted on rejoining the University.
- The Dean will sanction medical leave.
- Absence from examination for whatever reason will not make the student eligible for any benefit.
- Students intending to go outside the campus gate during working hours can do so with the permission of HOD.
- Maximum 10% of attendance can be given to the student on medical ground upon production of medical certificate and other required documents

EXAMINATION RULES

- There shall be two examination during the semester, followed by end of semester examination.
- It is compulsory for the students to appear in all the examinations.
- In case student falls ill/sick during the Exam-I or Exam-II, his/her leave application on the prescribed form supported by Medical Certificate should be submitted to concerned CoD/HoD/Dean to appear in Exam-III.
- A student found guilty of using unfair means during the examination will be given deterrent punishment. He/She may even be expelled from the University or disqualified from appearing in the University examination.

PROHIBITION OF USE OF INTOXICANTS/DRUGS

In recent times, there has been a noticeable rise in the incidence of the use of banned and prohibited substances by students. Besides being harmful, ingestion of these substances reduces inhibitions, increases risky behaviour, and often results in situations that put the health and safety of students, both the user and others, in serious jeopardy. Consequently, the possession, consumption or distribution of alcohol, or any intoxicant substance/ banned drugs that can induce an altered state of mind and behaviour in a person, is prohibited at Sant Baba Bhag Singh University. In addition, possession, distribution and use of cigarettes and tobacco are also banned for the health and well-being of all on the campus.

Any student/visitors found using, distributing or in possession of any Prohibited Substance will, in addition to the provisions of this Policy, also attract prosecution under the relevant laws. Such students may be suspended or expelled from the University.

B. HOSTEL RULES

HOSTEL ACCOMMODATION

- Separate boys & girls hostels are available. The hostel rooms are fully equipped with adequate modern furniture & fixtures.
- The facilities for recreation, indoor games, guest rooms, telephone, 24x7 water/electricity supply and medical facilities are available in the hostels. A central totally hygienic kitchen/mess for hostels has been established in each hostel.
- 100 Mbps Wi-Fi facility is available in hostel.
- Gym facility is available in hostel.

HOSTEL ROOM ALLOTMENT

- The student must be personally present at the time of allotment of rooms. Rooms to be allotted will be specified immediately before an allotment is made.
- The student can choose their roommates initially and make request for allotment accordingly.
- The boarder shall not be entitled to retain accommodation in the hostel beyond his/her normal period of study.
- No boarder is allowed to change his/her room without the permission of the warden.
- The boarder shall have to vacate accommodation as and when asked for.

FURNITURE AND EQUIPMENT (HOSTEL)

- Every boarder is provided with a chair, a table, a cot, a Book rack, a Cupboard and bedding. He/She will be responsible for these items and other electrical fittings, etc. Furniture and electrical fittings are not to be removed from one room to another. Every boarder is to see that no damage is done to the hostel property.
- Fitting & repair charges for any damage (intentional or negligence) are to be borne by the boarder concerned.
- Use of all electric appliances, except laptop, mobile charger and an extra table lamp, is prohibited.

HOSTEL ROOM RENT

The following is the room rent of hostel:

NORMAL ROOMS

03 seater room = ₹8000/- per semester per candidate.

02 seater room = ₹12000/- per semester per candidate.

Cooler Charges Extra.

AIR CONDITIONED ROOMS

02 seater room = ₹40,000/- per annum per candidate.

Hostel fee will be payable in lump sum and will not be accepted in installments. Room rent may change annually.

Note:

- Food charges will be extra and may vary from time to time.
- Students must make monthly payment of meals by 10th day of each month otherwise ₹10/- per day will be charged as fine.

- If a student is a hosteller and he is not staying in the hostel then the student has to pay ₹500/- per month to the mess contractor.

BOYS HOSTEL

- During winters, no student is allowed to go out of the complex after 6.00 pm. All students must return to the complex by 7.00 pm.
- During summers, no student is allowed to go out of the complex after 7.00 pm. All students must return to the complex by 8.00 pm.
- Night roll call will be taken between 7.00 pm to 9.00 pm.

GIRLS HOSTEL

- No girl student staying in hostel will remain outside the hostel after 8.00 pm both in summer and in winter.
- Night roll call will be taken between 6.00 pm to 7.00 pm.
- All girls must report to the warden during this time for marking the attendance.

GUESTS

- Guests are not, ordinarily, permitted to stay in the hostel except in the case of father/ brother & mother/sister (in case of girl students) provided he/she comes from a far off place at odd hours. The student must get permission for keeping his/her guest in the hostel from the Chief Warden. The guests so allowed will be kept in the hostel guestroom. Their names will be entered in the guest register kept in the hostel.
- Female guests are not permitted to stay in Boys hostel.
- Likewise male guests are not allowed to stay in the girl's hostel. A boarder keeping a guest without permission is liable for punishment.

ELECTRICITY

- Light, fans & coolers must be switched off when not in use. The use of electric heater, electric rod, electric tea kettle, etc. and other similar appliances is prohibited.
- Boarders are warned against tampering with electrical installation.
- For all electrical repairs the electrician should be called in.

BEHAVIOUR AND DISCIPLINE

- Hostellers are expected to display acceptable form of behaviour, maintain discipline and decorum in the hostel complex.
- Possession, distribution and consumption of alcoholic beverages, prohibited drugs, chewable tobacco and smoking in the hostel complex is not allowed.
- Parties/Gathering in hostel complex are not permitted without the prior and written consent of the chief warden.
- Hostellers must return to the hostel by 6.00 pm in winter and 7.00 pm in summer on off days after vacation or holidays as intimated by authorities.

- The hosteller will be allowed to stay out of hostel on submission of proper application duly authorized by parent and only if the permission is granted in writing by the authorities.

- Hostels should be a place where students can have the best possible conditions for studying and adequate rest. As such due consideration must be accorded to other hostellers at all times. Noise level must be kept low to allow other's opportunity to study and sleep in comfort. Television, Radio etc. provided in the common room must be switched off after 10.00 pm. These rules are intended to ensure a conducive environment for all hostellers. Personal music systems, woofers, etc. are not allowed. Students may listen to music by using earphones.

- Vandalism is very serious offence. Hostellers found guilty of committing such an offence can be evicted from the hostel and penalized.

- In case of any unacceptable behaviour by the room-mate, the other room-mate must report it to the college authorities.

- All kinds of shouting or any other act of movement or behaviour that is likely to cause disturbance or annoyance is strictly prohibited.

- Maltreating or showing disrespect to the hostel employees and canteen staff is strictly prohibited. In case of any complaint against them, the report should be made to the Hostel Warden.

- Dealing in general and specially with fellow students should be very courteous and polite. All disputes with fellow boarders should be avoided. Students must not take law into their own hands, but must report all disputes to the Hostel Warden.

- Teasing, maltreating or indulging in any sort of RAGGING of the newly admitted students is strictly prohibited. Serious disciplinary action will be taken against the defaulting students in accordance with the directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India.

- A boarder found guilty of having committed a breach of rules shall be liable to the punishment by the Warden as under.

- The Hostel Warden may issue a warning and/or impose fine on a defaulting student and may recommend expulsion from the Hostel/University.
- Rules listed on the wall at the entrance of the hostel must be read and strictly adhered to.

UPKEEP OF THE HOSTEL

- Hostellers are responsible for keeping their rooms clean and help in keeping common areas in the hostel such as visitor's area, bathrooms, stair case and common room etc. clean and tidy at all times.

- All fans, lights and electrical appliances must be switched off when not in use.

- Cooking, making tea, etc. is not allowed in the hostel rooms.

- Common hostel furniture must not be moved without the permission of the chief warden.

- Any damage to the hostel property must be reported immediately to the Warden/Chief Warden. Defaulting hosteller will be charged for all damages except damages caused by normal wear and tear.

- Pasting of posters, writing, wall chalking, slogans of any kind or defacing the hostel in any form is not allowed.

- The hostel management reserves the right to make spot checks during day & night on the hostel and rooms without having to give prior notice to the students.

- Electrician, contractors or any other service person may enter the room as and when necessary in the course of their duty under the directive of the warden/chief warden. However, every effort will be made to respect the privacy and dignity of the hosteller.

- The hostel management reserves the right to move hostellers to other hostel room/units if there is a necessity.

EMERGENCY

- In case of any emergency please contact the Warden/Chief Warden or call hostel authorities.

MEDICAL

- Hostellers should immediately inform the warden/chief warden in case of any medical problem to get immediate first aid or general medicine from Medical Room.

- Ambulance, if necessary, will also be available to send the student to Guru Nanak Sadh Sangat Hospital, Kalra, on the advice of in-charge, Medical Room.

VISITORS

Visitors including parents are allowed only into the visitors area of the hostel during the visiting hours as follows:

Weekend (Saturday) - 3.00pm to 6.00pm

Weekend (Sunday) and holidays - 9.30am to 4.00pm

- All visitors must register at the guard house/warden office and provide all details and documents as requested by Security before entering the hostel complex. All visitors must leave the hostel complex by the laid down timings.

- Hostellers are not permitted to allow their visitors into rooms at anytime for whatever reason. Any hosteller found violating this rule will be evicted from the hostel and penalized.

- Non-hostel students are prohibited in the hostel without the permission of warden. The students who violate this will be answerable to the warden.

SECURITY

- The hostel management is not responsible for any loss of private property. Hostellers are strongly advised to lock all their valuable e.g. Mobile Phones, Laptops, Watches, Money, etc. at all times.

- Hostellers are not permitted to change rooms or sleep anywhere other than in their own room.

- Any hosteller, who finds his/her room-mate missing after the roll call, or for more than 12 hours in day time, must report to the Warden/Chief Warden immediately. This enables the hostel authorities to take immediate action. Cooperation of the students will be very much appreciated.

- Possession, distribution and use of Fire Arms, Lethal Weapons including Air Gun, Contraband, Electric Appliances such as TV, VCR, Heater, Iron, electric kettle, Oven etc. in the rooms are prohibited.

Pets are not allowed in the hostel complex.

REVISION OF RULES AND REGULATIONS

- The hostel management reserves the right to revise the rules and regulation from time to time and will keep the hostellers informed of any changes in the form of notices on the hostel notice boards. Ignorance of rules will not be accepted as an excuse.

COMPLAINTS AND SUGGESTIONS

Any complaints, suggestions or enquiries are always welcome.

ADDITIONAL HOSTEL RULES FOR GIRL STUDENTS

- Each student shall present herself in the warden room to get herself marked present from 6.00 pm to 7.00 pm daily from Monday to Sunday except for the weekends commencing Friday evening to Monday morning, in case they are going home.

- For leaving from hostel, a slip shall be signed by the Warden putting the date and time of departure. This slip shall be signed by one of the parents after noting down the time and date at which the student reached her home.

- The same slip shall be signed by the parents noting the time and date of leaving from home for the University. The slip will be deposited with the Chief Warden/Warden.

- No student shall take a lift from any known or unknown person for going home and returning to the University/hostel. Only public transport or transport provided by SBBSMCS is to be used.

- For emergencies, the parents are requested to take their wards home personally or through a close relative duly authorised in writing and whose photographs are in the hostel record.

- A family photo of a girl student with father, mother, brother, sister, local guardian, etc. duly signed by each member, shall be kept in the records.

- Parent shall sign an affidavit regarding permission in case of they are willing to permit their student daughter to travel under her own arrangements independently from/to hostel. Before the start of session candidate is allowed to shift from one general course/department to another general course/department.
