Dr. Dharmjit Singh Parmar, Honorable Vice-Chancellor of Sant Baba Bhag Singh University, has proposed the idea of introducing Academic Prizes in the form of Roll of Honours to brilliant students, toppers, and University Colours to splendid sports persons for the first time. This initiative is intended to instill a sense of confidence and reward their efforts to cultivate a spirit within them during the 1st Annual Prize Distribution ceremony held in the Academic Session 2022-23. The 2nd Annual Prize Distribution Ceremony was conducted in accordance with this principle and was extended into the Academic Session 2023-24. The bona fide pass-out students of Sant Baba Bhag Singh University, who obtained highest cumulative grade point average (CGPA) with a minimum CGPA of 8.00 or greater; while completing all their courses without any reappear/backlog and cleared all the semesters (all the prescribed examinations) at the first attempt, before the programme's completion deadline, were selected for the award by the Academic committee comprised of Deans of different institutes. #### **BABA NANAK BAGICHI** ESTABLISHED AT SBBSU

With the heavenly blessings of Reverend Sant Baba Malkit Singh Ji and Reverend Baba Dlawar Singh Ji 'Brahm Ji', and with the benign endorsement of Baba Janak Singh Ji, and Honorable Chancellor Sant Manmohan Singh Ji, and under the valuable guidance of Honorable Vice-Chancellor Prof. (Dr.) Dharmjit Singh Parmar, the Sant Baba Bhag Singh University inaugurated "Baba Nanak Bagichi" established in collaboration with the Department of Forest and Wildlife Preservation, Jalandhar Division, Punjab. During inauguration ceremony, Baba Janak Singh Ji and Sant Manmohan Singh Ji, Honourable Chancellor of the University dedicated the "Baba Nanak Bagichi" to Reverend Sant Baba Malkit Singh Ji (Founder Chancellor) and Reverend Baba Dlawar Singh Ji 'Brahm Ji' (Second Chancellor) by raising the curtain and planting the saplings. Dr. Dharmjit Singh Parmar, Honorable Vice-Chancellor of the University said that this mini-forest "Baba Nanak Bagichi" is a tribute to Guru Nanak Dev Ji and it is established through a Japanese technique known as "Miyawaki technique". A dense forest in an area of more than 4200 square feet has been developed in the University campus to create dense forests with native plants. He mentioned that initiating such afforestation and biodiversity conservation activities is important for sustainable development and environment management. Also, he was extremely thankful to the University Management for providing basic infrastructural facilities and support for the development of this project. S. Hardam Singh Minhas, Honourable Secretary of Sant Baba Bhag Singh Educational Complex expressed his heartfelt gratitude to Baba Janak Singh Ji, Sant Manmohan Singh Ji (Honourable Chancellor), and the esteemed members of the management of the SBBSEC, Dr. Dharmjit Singh Parmar (Honorable Vice-Chancellor, SBBSU), S.
