




Figure: Poster Making Competition

of various diseases. She also shared her life experience where she has tackled various Patients. Dr. Sandeepani Saggar for sharing her valuable knowledge and expertise with the students.




Figure: Photograph with resource person on the occassion of World Heart Day

Students participated with greater interest. Villagers appreciated the effort and pledged to take appropriate measures regarding their health.





excel in life their respective fields. Dr Nisha Sharma Coordinator (Department of Physical Sciences) had also shared her experiences with faculty and students.


